Key Patient Member Roles & Responsibilities:

- Share the "Voice of the Patient" patient Committee members bring the Patient perspective to other ACHQC stakeholders (surgeons, clinical care teams, FDA, industry)
- Working with others on the Committee, offer input and recommendations on issues related to patient engagement & education
- Review and suggest feedback into ACHQC public data reporting and patient communications materials
- May make presentations to ACHQC groups, clinicians and others interested in enhancing patient abdominal core health

- Periodic review of materials/agenda prior to each committee meeting
- Attend committee meeting at the Annual QI Summit (optional)
